


## Data in PhD theses at Lille university > Volumetry

### Corpus 283 theses

- 31% print
- 69% digital
- 66% with data in appendices

### **Appendices**


- 25 000 pages






## Corpus exploration

A main volume with text and classification plan


A volume of appendices including catalog with 179 notices

## Barriers to open data

Incomplete, inadequate or missing description






Datasets and/or individual data are not or incompletely documented

Research data are presented without any structuration or organisation, often together with other, not reusable material in a kind of information mash-up not suitable for further research

Data and text are glued together in a PDF file instead of being separated and published in adequate file formats





## Data management : practices & needs The PhD students



### Recommandations

Clear separation of text and data. Digital research data must be submitted in different and separate files

Separation

The data must be described in a standard language and format. with sufficient detail for retrieval and data mining

Metadata



Structuration

Deposit in open and original format to facilitate long-term preservation and reuse

Clearing of privacy and copyright issues

- Online resources (guidelines, FAQ...)
- Alert service

Education



- Legal and technical help (data management plan)
- Technical assistance for deposit
- Liaison with laboratories

Advice, assistance



- Mediation for deposit

- Development of tools on the campus
