Introduction

Dear colleagues,

We would like to ask you to participate in a survey on the implementation of **persistent identifiers** (DOI, ORCID, ROR, RAiD) in the information systems of research institutions in the Czech Republic. The survey is being carried out by the National Library of Technology within the CARDS project for the purpose of determining the **current status and planned development of integrations** of identifiers in these information systems. The gathered data will be used for the ongoing cost benefit analysis of implementing persistent identifiers in the Czech Republic.

- **Grant management system** – a system for managing grant projects from application submission through implementation to billing.

- **HR system** – a system for managing employee data, including records of researchers, their qualifications and employment relationships.
