


Methodology | Terms and Conditions

How to search:

- This database search looks for all matches of exact words in the EU fund project titles, beneficiaries and descriptions.
- At this stage, it distinguishes between accents, so searching for Punta Umbria Turistica gives different results to Punta Umbria Turistica (note the accent on the "i"s).
- You can translate search words to look for key words in other languages so having searched for council, you
 can search for council in any of the 23 EU languages.


