• User interface

- Facetted search
- Information on how to make the document more prominent
- Possibility to export records in XML and Zotero
- Export search results as an RSS file
- Content
 - Add records from 2005 onwards from current partners
 - Open the database to new European partners
 - Links to full text for existing records

System for Information on Grey Literature in Europe, is your open access to 700.000 bibliographical references of grey literature (paper) produced in Europe and allows you to export records and locate the documents.

Examples of grey (gray) literature include technical or research reports, doctoral dissertations, some conference papers, some official publications, and other types of grey literature.

OpenGrey covers Science, Technology, Biomedical Science, Economics, Social Science and Humanities.

The site includes preprints from the GL conferences (GreyNet International) in full text.



Enhanced Publications

- Definition from DRIVER-II:
 - "A publication that is enhanced with three categories of information:
 - 1)Research data
 - 2)Extra materials
 - 3)Post-publication data"
- Included in repositories –
 <u>OpenGrey</u>, <u>NRGL</u>
- Special repositories <u>DANS</u>

Enhanced Publications Project

- Data exchange is becoming the standard in OA communities
- Research data should be preserved and accessible
- A data policy should be in place within research organizations
- Data should be recognized in references and citations
