Sector of employment

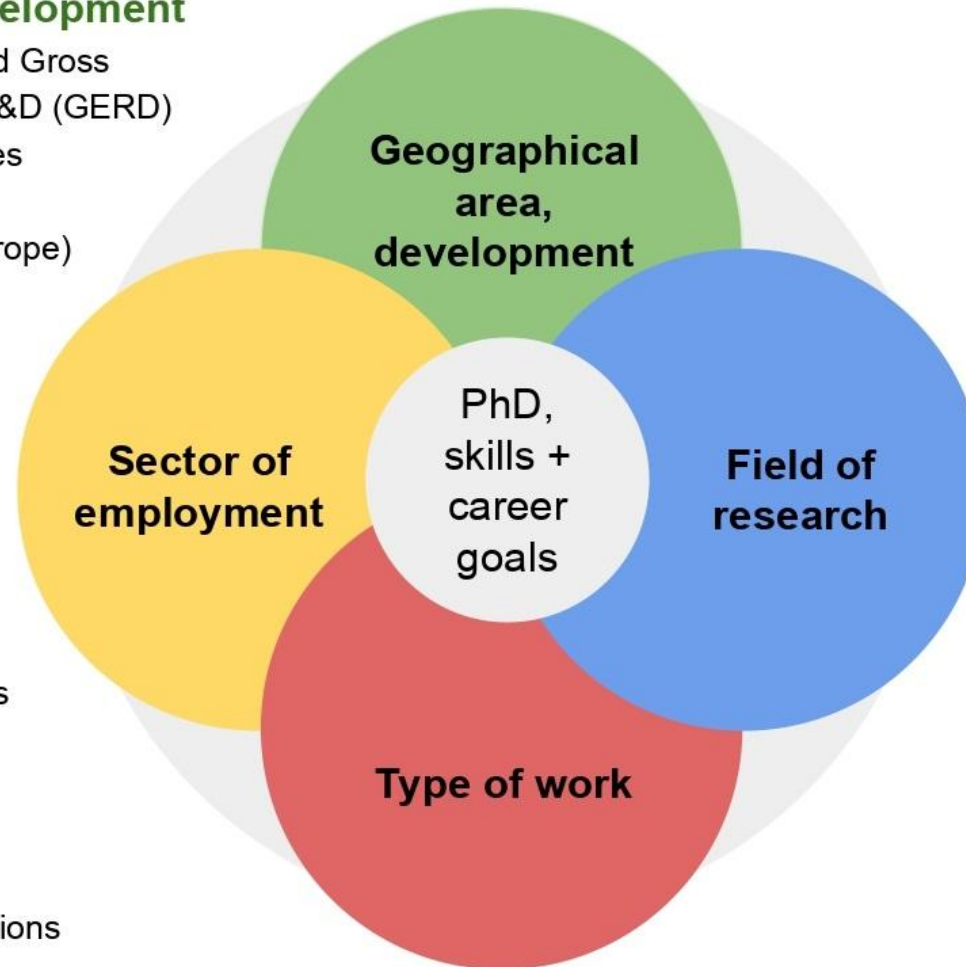
- Higher education and research organisations (e.g. research institutes)

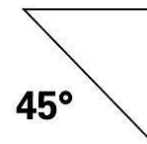
