The Electronic Information Service National Programme (EIS)

- Established in 2001 in order to support higher education and research with electronic information
- Different types of databases from full text periodicals to factual information databases.
- Moved to the Hungarian Academy of Sciences in 2013
- EIS Department works in the structure of the Library and Information Centre of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences.
- 185 member institutions
- 89 databases
- 22 million EUR annual budget

Strategic Priorities

- Extensive research support to the Hungarian higher education and research sphere with providing access to scientific content.
- Making the Hungarian research output visible and supporting innovation with offering Open Access publishing through the Read and Publish contracts.
- Participating in the national strategy by providing access to Hungarian scientific content to the Hungarian institutions beyond the boarder.

The Programme Board

- governing council of EIS National Programme
- established by the President of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences, and operating in collaboration with EIS Department. Board members represent the participating institutions and the financing authorities.
- Tasks
 - representing the demands of the research community
 - creating the strategy of development
 - evaluating the operation
 - approval of the yearly procurement and budget plan
 - The Board members perform their duties voluntarily and without remuneration.

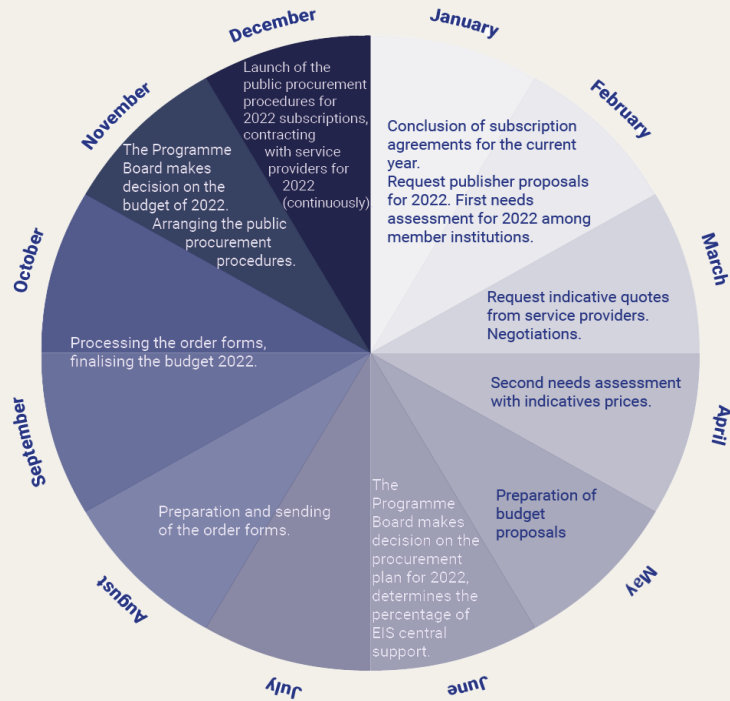
185 institutions

- Higher Education Institutions
- Research Institutions (Eötvös Loránd Research Network)
- Governmental Institutions
- Healthcare Institutions (mainly hospitals)
- Special Libraries, Public Libraries
- Museum, Archives

Financer body

- The Programme is partly financed by National Research, Development and Innovation Office and the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (ca 1/3 of the budget)
- The member institutions pay the other 2/3 according to their size and research output.
- The proportion of the state fund is decided by the Board based on the recommendation of the EIS department. The state fund proportions are determined according to the **strategic priorities** of the Programme.

Annual workflow



National Consortium

- A consortia is built around a publisher or a specific database service.
- The minimum number of consortia institutions are 4 institutions.
- The largest consortia has more than 50 members.
- 72 consortium, 89 databases.

Contracts, Read & Publish

- A contract is the result of public procurement procedure (negotiated procedure without a prior contract notice)
- It takes ca. 8-10 weeks.
- 16 Journal Read & Publish contracts: it contains a subscription fee and a publication fee or the Subscription fee is included with exact number/unlimited number of articles.
- 28 R&P Hungarian OA Book contracts. 2/3 of the current books are OA, 1/3 are closed to keep the subscribing consortia.

The Team

- Deputy director general as responsible for / coordinator
- 2 ps full-time
- 2 ps 30 hours /week
- 2 ps multitasking:
 - Head of the Collection Development Department
 - Member of the Science Policy and Scientometrics Department
- Financial Department
